DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

STALLINGTON ROAD, BLYTHE BRIDGE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Stallington Road in Blythe Bridge so much as passes by and is in the direct vicinity of the level crossing for a distance of 20 metres either side unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Stallington Road, A521 Uttoxeter Road, B5029 Grindley Lane, A520 Windmill Hill, B5066 Hilderstone Road and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://roadworks.org?tm=155738>.

The order will come into operation at 21:00 hours on 24 July 2017 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 07:00 hours on 25 July 2017.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the level crossing inspection works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
