**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC  
STUBWOOD LANE, DENSTONE**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 31 July 2018 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Stubwood Lane in Denstone from its junction with Taylors Lane to its junction with Red Hill unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Red Hill, Station Road, B5030 Rocester Bypass, B5031 New Road, B5031 Main Road, B5031 Elm View, College Road, Oak Road, Stubwood Hollow and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://roadworks.org?tm=105813772>.

**The order will come into operation on 6 August 2018 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date taking place daily between the hours of 08:00 and 16:00. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 August 2018.**

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the blockage clearing works undertaken by A-Plant Lux Traffic Controls Ltd on behalf of BT Openreach, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
