**Moss Lane
Mossgate**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 27th August 2019 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Moss Lane in Mossgate from its junction with Balaams Lane to a point approximately 670 metres in a South-Easterly direction unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Moss Lane, Cresswell Road, B5066 Hilderstone Road, Balaams Lane and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://roadworks.org?tm=113973879>.

The order will come into operation on 2nd September 2019 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10th September 2019.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the overhead cable and pole replacement works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
